The **Nutrition Counselor (RD or CN)** is part of an integrated team of providers - along with mental health therapists, interns, and operations staff - who are responsible for providing the most healing and inclusive standard of care for clients. The nutrition counselor provides individual dietary counseling and coordination of care, as well as facilitation for therapeutic and/or support groups, if desired. The nutrition counselor is a vital member of our outpatient healing community in upholding Liberating Jasper's core values of anti-racism, anti-oppression, trauma-informed, fat-positive, weight-inclusive, and compassionate body liberation work.

This position requires a minimum of 20 client session hours per week. Benefits at 20+ hours per week include: medical/dental/vision insurance and paid time off. The rate of pay for this position is \$60/hr.

Applicants with underrepresented identities in the eating disorder field are strongly encouraged to apply.

Job responsibilities and expectations include:

- Practicing from a clinical approach aligned with Liberating Jasper's core values
- Conducting a minimum of 20 client sessions per week, which requires scheduling 22-24 per week to account for cancellations/no-shows
- Completing all clinical notes and documentation by noon on Monday for the previous week

- Attending weekly staff meetings, trainings, and group consultation
- Participating in weekly supervision
- Conducting initial, weekly, and discharge sessions with clients centering individualized and personal eating disorder care
- Collaborating with Liberating Jasper therapy team and outside providers for continuity of care
- Responding to new client assignments within 2 business days
- Contributing to the organizational culture in a positive and collaborative manner

Candidate Must-Haves:

- Master's degree
- Certified dietitian (RD) or nutritionist (CN) in Washington state, or have the ability to obtain certification prior to starting date
- Eating disorder, anti-diet, anti-oppression, fat-positive, Health at Every Size®, and Body Trust®-informed experience and values
- 1-2 years experience in the body liberation and/or eating disorder fields
- Be comfortable providing both in-person and virtual sessions
